

## Online Summer School

### 2011 Facts Sheet

**Registration:** Online at: [www.vlearn.ca](http://www.vlearn.ca) April 15<sup>th</sup> until May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011  
**Register early as registrations will be closed when capacity for each course is reached.**

**Note:** Not all students are suitable candidates for taking courses online. The self-directed, capable and motivated student who is comfortable using computers is most likely to be successful in the online environment.

**Dates:** May 15<sup>th</sup> to July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011. In order to participate in online courses during the summer session all students must become active in their courses prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>. Daily work on courses will be required to ensure they are completed prior to July 29<sup>th</sup>.

**Times:** Daily as required by the teacher and course completion demands. Online courses can be accessed from the vLearn.ca web servers by students 24/7 for the duration of the course.

**Provincial Exams:** Required attendance for e-exam writing for **Social Studies 11** will be held on Wednesday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011 from 9:00am-11:00am. Students must bring photo identification and arrive 15 minutes early.

**Exam Location:** W.L. Seaton Secondary, 2701-41<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Vernon BC.

**Cost:** **All online courses are free to school aged students.** Students registered in Social Studies 10 and 11 will need to pay an \$80.00 textbook deposit and Family Studies students will need to pay a \$60.00 deposit. The deposits are to be paid prior to starting the course and are payable by cash or cheque. Students can pick up the textbooks at The Open Door Education Centre, 2901-29<sup>th</sup> Street, Vernon BC. All deposits will be refunded when the texts have been returned in good condition.

**Marks:** Marks will be available from the teachers upon course completion. Marks will also be forwarded to the home school.
